Fire Fighting Training

MDPC Training Department provides a practical and more advanced form of firefighting training for safety and disaster prevention, using mock-up ship and fire-fighting facilities. The levels of training consists of a myriad of ranges, from basic to advanced levels and control, foam/dry chemical extinguishers and water fog.

Oil Spill Control Training

Training Department provides lectures on predicting the scope of forecasting slick movements, controlling spilled oil, and establishing a contingency plan. Training Department has also implemented exercises on handling oil recovery equipment and shoreline clean-up. In addition to implementation, Training department has also taught how to arrange resources, equipment, notify concerning institutions, and respond to the proper entities within news outlets and mass media to rectify catastrophes affecting the general public. The course covers training for oil spill response, in which the curriculum is prepared by the IMO.



Chemical and HNS control training

Training Department also provide lecture and exercise for detection work of poisonous gas wearing protective clothing etc. for the crew of Chemical Tanker, of the search and lifesaving etc. for the crew of Passenger Boat.

DAINI-KAIHOU, which is a man-made island, was made in Tokyo Bay from 1889 to 1914 by Japanese military.

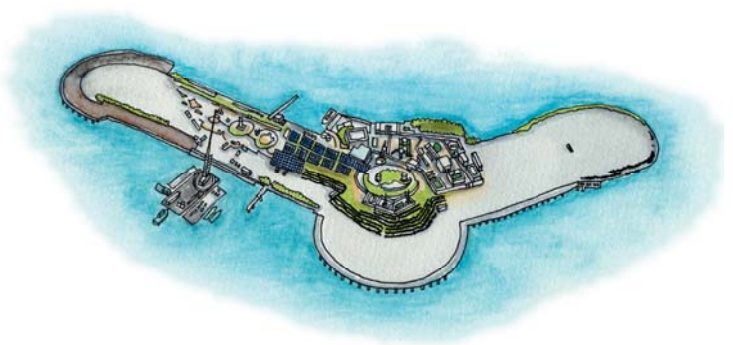
Training Department has training facility on the island and provides HM response trainings and firefighting trainings
